

The approval for GreenItaly 2025, granted by AIPH Members during the <u>AIPH Spring Meeting 2025</u> in <u>Thailand</u>, underscores the event's international significance. Italian International Trade Expo for Horticulture

GreenItaly 2025 aims to become an important annual hub showcasing the entire value chain for flowers, plants, and nursery stock, including production, technology, floristry, garden features, landscaping, and point-of-sale solutions.

It will take place at the Pala Verdi convention centre, which is unlike a conventional exhibition hall, as it serves as an actual theatre space, providing a stage to showcase the best in horticulture and urban greenery. The unique setting will provide exhibitors and visitors a dynamic and immersive experience, boasting a total exhibition area of 17,000 m², including a plenary space of 4,000 m², add to this an expansive stage area of 400 m² and a ceiling height of 24 metres, there is plenty of room and space to accommodate the expected 8,000 professional visitors.





A Dedicated Event for Urban Greenery

GreenItaly 2025 will be showcasing urban greenery and the nursery production of ornamental plants for parks, gardens, and tree-lined avenues. Collaborating with the international horticultural industry is crucial, and the endorsement from AIPH highlights this commitment. This recognition enhances the event's global profile and solidifies its role as an important gathering for the horticultural trade, offering exhibitors increased visibility and valuable industry connections.

It will serve as a global platform for industry leaders, growers, and stakeholders to share knowledge, demonstrate best practices, and celebrate advancements in sustainable horticulture. With a strong emphasis on environmental responsibility, innovation, and economic impact, the event aligns perfectly with AIPH's mission to promote the power of plants in creating a greener, healthier world.

As a further contribution to the international horticultural community, *Lineaverde*, a bilingual, online magazine providing a comprehensive overview of the European floriculture industry, is a media partner, reinforcing GreenItaly's information and networking hub role.

GreenItaly 2025 will be the ideal exhibition for designers, builders, and green space managers, providing access to a wide range of plants, furnishings, technical tools, technologies, and machinery for ornamental plant cultivation and green space creation and management.
